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FACILITY: Princeton University is an 8 lane **50 meter** pool located on Faculty Road. Colorado Timing System will be used during the meet.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be members in good standing with their YMCA

ENTRY FEES: \$5.00 per individual event. There will be **no** refunds given for entry fees if the meet is cancelled or shortened due to weather.

ENTRIES: Team Manager Entries should be emailed to summersplash09@optonline.net no later than **Tuesday June 23, 2009**. Entries must be in long course meters. Payment should be made to HAC and mailed to Sue Welsh, 20 Birchwood Ct, Princeton Jct., NJ, 08850. The TM events file will be posted at www.hamiltonaquatics.com after May 27, 2009.

MEET FORMAT: This meet will be run as a timed final meet. No awards will be given. The 2009 USA Swimming Technical Rules shall govern this meet. All events are open. The Meet Director reserves the right to amend the events or limit heats.

CHECK IN: The entire meet will be deck seeded. All coaches must turn in check-in sheets by 10:45 AM. **Scratches should have the names circled with the word “SCR” next to the name. Scratches from events should have the event number circled and the “SCR”. All other swimmers should have a line through their name signifying the Swimmer will swim in all events entered.** Any swimmer who has not checked in will be scratched from the session.

ADMISSIONS: There will be no admission fee to the facility. There will be Heat Sheet Programs available for sale.

RESULTS: A zip file will be posted immediately following the meet at www.hamiltonaquatics.com. Please advise if you need a hard copy of the meet results.

OFFICIALS: Participating clubs are requested to provide at least 2 level 1 or level 2 YMCA officials or USA certified officials. The official’s coordinator for each team should email the list of the officials with their level of certification, who will be working the meet to the meet referee.

CONDUCT: Proper conduct at all times will be enforced by coaches, parents, marshals, and the meet director.

TIMERS: Participating clubs will be asked to provide timers with stopwatches. Teams maybe asked to cover multiple lanes. The timing assignments will be sent to the coaches and will also be posted on www.hamiltonaquatics.com.

COACHES: All coaches must display a valid YMCA or US Swimming coaching card at all times while on deck.

DIRECTIONS: Take Route 1 South to Route 571 (Washington Rd.). Make a right and follow Washington Rd. to first light (Faculty Rd.). Make a right on Faculty Rd. the parking lot will be on your left past DeNunzio Pool.
